Qualification Standards

- At night, from a vehicle, using a spotlight for illumination, place five (5) consecutive shots into a 75-mm circle marked on an A4 size target (representing a kangaroo head silhouette) at a range of 100 metres.
- Minimum calibre for assessment is centrefire of any calibre - max 308.

Assessment Questions

1. What must be considered before undertaking a spotlighting activity?
2. Who is responsible for all the participants' safety?
3. What are the speed limits with people in the back of the ute, while spotlighting and in transit?
4. How many people may be in the back of a ute and how many may shoot?
5. When may a firearm be loaded?
6. What action is to be taken before people alight from the vehicle?
7. To reduce fatigue, how often should rest breaks be held?
8. What action is to be taken when approaching a dwelling or another vehicle during spotlight activities?
9. Who may drive the vehicle?
10. What documentation must the shooter(s) have on them?

Assessment Criteria	Competent

Handles firearm safely with muzzle in safe direction at all times.		
Can describe or demonstrate the appropriate action in the event of a misfire / malfunction.		
Demonstrated returning the loaded firearm to a safe state (clear – empty chamber).		
Explained / described the safety factors which must be considered before firing.		
Safely adopts a shooting position from within a vehicle or on the tray, resting and shooting over the roof of the vehicle.		
Successfully placed five (5) consecutive shots within the target area under spotlight conditions.
